

Reserve Affairs Safety Briefing

Introduction - On behalf of the MCAAP Commander Col Timothy Beckner and Civilian Deputy Mr. Gary Reasnor, welcome to MCAAP.

- Accidents or incidents – All accidents and incidents will be reported to Reserve Affairs immediately.
- Safety is everyone’s business. Report unsafe acts to your chain of command who will notify Reserve Affairs, Safety, Fire Department, or Security. Those phone numbers are on the back of your installation badge.
- Injury – Any injuries that occur requiring medical attention will be called in to the fire department (using installation phone: 6-911/using cell phone: 918-420-6911). All injuries will be reported to Reserve Affairs.
- Alcohol – Alcohol will only be consumed in designated areas: After Hours Club, Murphy’s Meadow, Family Housing, and Camp Plea Pavilion. The only exception will be a written request from a unit’s Battalion Commander requesting the consumption of alcohol in a non-designated drinking area.
- Obey all traffic signs - Speeding and not stopping at stop signs are number one violations. MCAAP Security uses radar guns. If you get a ticket it will go to your unit’s commander who will have to respond back in writing on actions taken.
- Railroad crossings – MCAAP has 209 miles of railroad tracks and eight (8) locomotives; we have no protected railroad crossings. Make sure that when approaching a railroad track to look both ways and prepare to stop. When hauling ammo vehicles must stop at all railroad crossings.
- Cell phones – Cell phone use without a hands free device is prohibited on MCAAP.
- Smoking past Gate 14 – Smoking is only allowed in designated smoking areas.
- Wild life – Don’t pet wild life.
- Swimming pool – Swimming is not authorizing unless MWR staff is present.
- Photos – No photo will be taken without a photo permit. All photos will be obtained through Reserve Affairs and the Safety Office.
