MR. GARY D. REASNOR **CIVILIAN DEPUTY, MCALESTER ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT**

Mr. Gary D. Reasnor assumed his position as Civilian Deputy on July 11, 2004. In this capacity, he is responsible for managing the mission programs, the safety, security, quality and reliability of the munitions stockpile, maintenance of the infrastructure and formulating long-range strategic plans and policies to efficiently and effectively accomplish the mission.

Before assuming the position of Civilian Deputy, Mr. Reasnor served as the Plant's chief engineer where he directed and coordinated plant engineering and public work's activities. His duties included ammunition production and demilitarization, facility engineering, family housing, land management, real property and utilities construction, operations, maintenance and repair.

Mr. Reasnor's varied experience in both the private industry and federal government includes a highly responsible supervisory/managerial position within the petroleum industry. In April 1985, he accepted a position at McAlester AAP as a Supervisory Civil Engineer in the Engineering Directorate. He later served as the plant's Environmental Coordinator, Chief of the Operations and Maintenance Division, Chief of the Engineering Support Division, and Chief of the Engineer Resources Management Division prior to his assignment as the Director of Engineering and Public Works.

Mr. Reasnor received a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Oklahoma in 1980. He obtained his Professional Engineer Certification in February 1989.

He is a graduate of the Depot and Arsenal Executive Leadership Program administered by the Institute for Defense and Business and taught in partnership with the University of North Carolina Kenan-Flagler Business School.
