MISSION: McAlester Army Ammunition Plant produces, sustains, delivers, recovers and demilitarizes conventional and missile ammunition to support Joint Forces worldwide in order to enable successful U.S. military operations.

HISTORY: MCAAP was established May 20, 1943 as the McAlester Naval Ammunition Depot. It became part of the Army's Single Manager for Conventional Ammunition Oct. 1, 1977. Under Base Realignment and Closure 2005, MCAAP acquired additional workload from Red River Munitions Center, Texas. From Kansas Army Ammunition Plant, it acquired the Sensor Fuzed Weapon and missile warhead production, and from Red River Munitions Center, Lone Star Army Ammunition Plant, and Sierra Army Depot, it acquired demilitarization, storage and maintenance functions.

STATISTICS: In fiscal year 2014, MCAAP has an operating budget of \$195.1 million and a payroll of \$111.9 million. There are 1,443 Department of the Army civilians and one Soldier.

FACILITIES: MCAAP is housed on 44,964 acres with 2,826 buildings, including 2,263 earth-covered storage magazines and 163 storage warehouses, and a storage capacity of 8,840,559 square feet.
