

Request for Mobilization Ordnance Specific Training (MOST)

1. Unit contacts MOST POC and schedules training for 1-3 week rotation, as soon as possible but at least 90 days in advance of training dates.
 - a. Establish course dates for units to select. If training period is taken units may use other MOST depots.
 - b. Look into possibly using RFMSS
 - c. Leader recon
 - d. Transportation requirement
 - e. Support Costs (laundry, fuel, manpower)
 - f. Identify equipment needed (MHE/CHE)
 - g. Unit responsible for all damages.
2. Depot MOST POC sends unit MOST POI's and training task list to complete requested training plan and risk assessment.
3. Unit completes training plan and template risk assessment, once on the ground daily risk assessment, then sends to MOST POC; also identifies life support requirements. Any security requirements, if needed. Unit submits standard name line of soldiers attending training (Name, SSN, rank).
4. MOST POC office sends training plan to Mission Ops for review, and approval or requested modifications. Operations may change from time it is approved, revalidate 30 days out? MIPR/credit card funds 10 days prior to training dates, in needed.
5. Mission Ops develops MOST support plan based on number of soldiers and workload requirements.
6. Unit arrives, in-brief (safety brief), all personnel badged/cleared to enter work area and meet with Mission Ops Supervisors to verify training plan.
7. Out-process/out-brief. AAR required prior to departing depot.

Elective Tasks:
