HISTORY: MCAAP was established May 20, 1943 as the McAlester Naval Depot. It became part of the Army's Single Manager for Conventional Ammunition in 1977. It acquired Red River Munitions Center in 1999. MCAAP acquired additional workload as a result of Base Realignment and Closure 2005. From Kansas Army Ammunition Plant, it acquired the Sensor Fused Weapon and missile warhead production, and from Red River Munitions Center, Lone Star Army Ammunition Plant, and Sierra Army Depot, it acquired demilitarization, storage and maintenance functions.

STATISTICS: In fiscal year 2019, MCAAP had an operating budget of \$246 million and a payroll of \$148 million. There are 1,665 Department of the Army civilians and one Soldier.

FACILITIES: MCAAP is housed on 44,964 acres with 2,826 buildings including 2,263 igloos and storage capacity of 6.3 million square feet.
